Warrior Red Rips at Rincon Races

March 1, 2008 - Carpinteria

The smell of freshly churned grass at the shot ring complemented the clang of the blocks on the track for the perennial immersion of the senses at the Rincon Races, the traditional opening meet of the season for CHS Track and Field. High quality performances abounded as the team took on Fillmore, Nordhoff, Santa Ynez, Morro Bay and Cate. Although the team didn't finish in the top three in any division, quite a few Warriors had major PR's and top finishes.

The varsity boys 4x100 meters relay team finished first with a time of 46.82. Francisco Lugo, Ivan Millholin, Alex Cuevas, and Steven Lozier comprised the team. Strong man Lugo sprinted to a personal best 13.28 in the 100 meters as well as finishing 5th in the shot put with a 36-04 heave. Ivan also competed in the 100 meters where he finished 5th at 12.57. Alex finished 1st in the 200 meters with a 23.61 second clocking. The other relay, the 4x400, saw Gabe Flores, Erick Esqueda, Steven Lozier, and Javier Perez finish 2nd in a combined time of 3:47.91. Erick and Javier both had PR splits. Javier ran a 53.6 while Esqueda ran a 54.2. Javier also had a 1st place finish in his primary event, the 110 high hurdles with a 17.90. Erick had earlier success in the 600 meters by coming to a picture posed 2nd place finish at 1:29.36, a new personal best. Gabe was the other distance stand out with a PR performance of 4:05.65 in the 1200 meters. On the field, Emmanuel Casillas made his debut performance with a 4th place finish of 18-05 1/4 in the long jump and 5-00 clearance in the high jump to garner 5th. Javier Flores was 3rd in the discus with a 118-06 toss.

The girls made their debut with several 1st place performances. The 4x400 meter relay had Tesa Coleman, Nicole Spaeth, Brianna Stout, and Kacey Nomura run a combined time of 4:28.09. Brianna had a stout performance with a 66.5 personal best, in addition to a 4:22.80 PR in the 1200 meters. Kacey ran 28.04 to finish in the lead spot in the 200 meters. Tesa was 5th in the 600 meters with a 1:58.43 personal best. Nicole matched her training partners 5th place with a 4:19.73 in the 1200 meters. On the field, Valerie Chamlee popped a 3rd place finish in shot put with a 26-09. In the same event Catie Clemency had a 16-01 PR. Carina Celio shone in the long and triple jumps with 1st place finishes in both. She leapt for a 15-02 1/2 in the See RINCON, page 2

long and a 32-06 1/2 in the triple. Lucy Musson finished 5th in the long jump with 13-11 1/2.

The girls junior varsity also had a winning relay with a 56.21 in the 4x100. Amanda Burch, Shelby Dunlap, Natalie Hipple, and Ally Winn comprised the team. The team was full of 1st and 2nd place finishes. Ally was 1st at 13-06 in the long jump and 2nd in the 200 meters at 29.46. Natalie was right behind her with a 13-01 1/2 2nd place long jump finish. Amanda finished 1st in the triple jump with a 29-07 3/4 leap. Shelby earned her victory in the 100 meters with 14.21 second dash. Jennifer Leonard was 5th at 15.09. Gina Targoni palced 2nd in the discus with a 71-02 heave. Katie Buchmiller turned in a personal best with a 56-02 effort. She also finished 4th in the 300 meters hurdles with a 63.45 second time.

The boys frosh/soph team had a 1st place 4x400 meters team. Andy Wills, Brian Jaramillo, Grant Coleman, and Travis Madden ran 4 laps in 3:59.17. Grant had a 62.6 PR. This was a capitalization on earlier success in the 600 meters where he earned the first victory of his career with a 1:38.80. Travis finished 4th in the 1200 meters with a 3:45.66. Andy had a new personal best in the 100 meters with a 13.15, he also PR'd in the discus at 77-04. Andrew McDonough's 25.88 second sprint captured a 1st place in the 200 meters. He also placed 2nd in the long jump and triple jump. He soared 16-04 1/2 in the single jump and 33-02 1/2 in the 3 phase jump. Scott Buffon placed 5th at 28-00 1/2 in the same event. Erick Cruz was 4th in the 2400 meters with a 9:07.27 personal best. Travis Doop had a super day with a PR 3rd place finish in the 300 intermediate hurdles with a time of 52.52. He also was 4th place in a tie at 7-06 in the pole vault. In the throws, John Bustillos threw the solid Frisbee for a 91-01 personal best victory in the discus. He was 4th in the shot put at 35-07, another PR. Marcell Lee was 2nd in the round implement toss with a 40-07 1/2 personal best. He was 4th in the discus with an 87-00 PR. Isaiah Chavez was 5th in the discus with an 85-03 debut performance. Cameron Gonzales came in 5th at 34-02 3/4 in the shot, a new personal best as well.


The Warriors from Westmont took the weekend off. Look for updates from Montecito in the next issue of the *Warrior Journal*.
